Payment Policy

- Registrations are not considered firm until payment is received.
- For online registrations, payment is required upon checkout via credit card (Visa, Mastercard or AMEX).
- Other accepted methods of payment are direct bank transfer and manual credit card payments (should you choose to give your credit card details over the phone).
- Payments are fully automated with an immediate response via email confirmation together with a tax invoice.
